The Arabic Alphabet

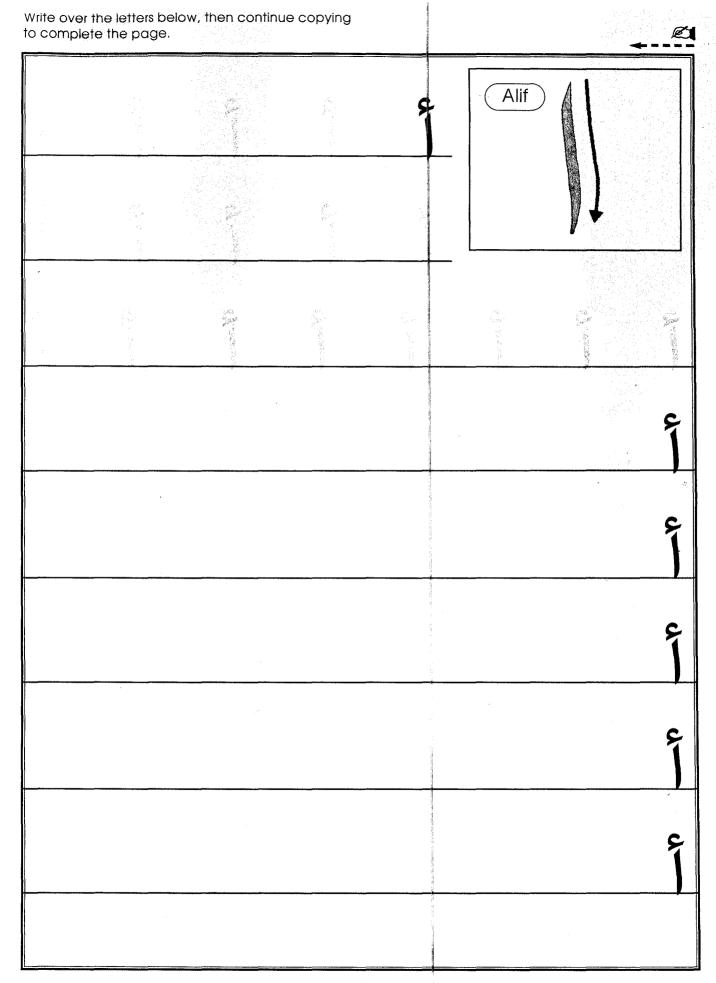
In order to learn any language, one must first master the alphabet and be able to read, write and pronounce it correctly.
