 - Chapter 1: Searching for the Truth: The Journey of Salman Al-Farisi (7 Exam Questions)
 - Describe Salman Al-Farisi.
 - Know that Salman Al-Farisi's people were Majoos and they used to worship fire.
 - Relate his life story.
 - Know that Salman was informed of 3 signs to determine if the Prophet was a true Prophet:
 1. The seal of Prophethood on his back between his shoulders
 2. He accepts and eats from gifts
 3. He does not eat from charity
 - Be able to explain what Salmaan meant by the statement to Abu Dardaa: ""Your Lord has a right on you, and your wife and family have rights on you; so you should respect the rights of all those who have a right on you". Explain this statement."
 - Know that the meaning of Abud-Dardaa's statement: "Your Lord has a right on to you, your body has a right on you, and your wife and family have rights on you; so you should respect the rights of all those who have a right on you" is that a Muslim should not neglect the needs of his body and family.
 - Chapter 2: All Arabia Attacked Madinah (5 Exam Questions)
 - Describe the events that led to The Battle of the Trench.
 - Know that the Battle of Khandaq occurred in the 5th year of hijra.
 - Describe the Muslims plan to defend Madina.
 - Know that the meaning of seerah is the life of Prophet Muhammad
 - Describe the disbelievers plans to attack Madina.
 - Know the 3 things Bani Nadeer knew they had to do to defeat the Muslims.
 - Chapter 3: Muslims Under Siege: The Battle of Al-Khandaq (8 Exam Questions)
 - Describe how the Muslims were betrayed during the Battle of Al-Khandaq.
 - Describe the disbelievers' plans to invade Madina.
 - Know that Al-Aws and Al-Khazraj were the main (Muslim) tribes of Medinah.
 - Describe the events that led to the failure of the tribes' attack.
 - Be able to explain the role of Nu'aym Ibn Mas'ood in helping the Muslims defeat the Disbelievers in the Battle of Khandaq.
 - Know that the siege of Medina during the Battle of Khandaq lasted for 1 month.
 - Learn and memorize the dua of the chapter for protection by Allah.
 - Know the dua that the Muslims made when they were afraid of their enemies during the Battle of the Trench: Oh, Allah, hide our weaknesses and grant us security!
