- 1) Dhikr is something we say to remember and thank Allah (SWT)

- 2) Ni'mah is any blessing from Allah (SWT)
 - a. Examples: parents, eyes, nose, mouth, ears
- 3) Names of Allah (SWT)
 - a. Al-Wahid: The One
 - b. Al-Musawwir: The Shaper of Beauty
 - c. Al-Azeem: The Great
 - d. Al-Wadood: The Loving
- 4) Arkan ul Iman means "pillars of faith" in English
 - a. 6 pillars=> We believe in:
 - i. Allah (SWT)
 - ii. Angels
 - iii. Holy Books
 - iv. Prophets
 - v. The Day of Judgement
 - vi. Al-Qadar (the will of Allah)

 - a. Parents' names: Abdullah and Aminah
 - b. Place of Birth: Makkah
 - c. Grandfather's name: Abdul-Muttalib
 - d. Uncle's name: Abu Talib
 - e. First job: shepherd
 - f. Second job: merchant
