 - Identify Khadeeja, may Allah be pleased with her.
 - Know that Khadeejah comforted the Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him, when he came back from the cave of Hira' frightened from his first meeting with Angel Jibreel, by reminding him that Allah will not abandon him because: he is honest and truthful, he helps the needy and honors his guests.
 - Identify Waraqah, the cousin of Khadeejah, may Allah be pleased with her.
 - Know that it was the cousin of his wife Khadeejah, Waraqah, a wise man, who first explained to the Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him, what he saw in the cave of Hira' and that it was an angel from Allah who had visited him.
 - Recognize and understand the name of Allah: An-Noor.
 - Know that one of Allah's names is An-Noor, The Light, because he is the light of the heavens and of the earth. He guides his prophets and servants to the truth.
